CHRONOLOGY OF MUḤAMMAD (according to Islamic tradition)

- 570 Birth of Muhammad (father already dead).
- 576 Mother dies. Under care of grandfather.
- 578 Grandfather dies. Under care of Abū Ṭālib.
- 595 Marries Khadīja.
 - Subsequent visit to Syria after marriage?
- 610 First revelation. Suras 96, 74 (or 68 and 93).
- 615(?) Migration to Abyssinia.
- 616 Boycott of Hāshim clan.
- 617 Battle of Bu`āth in Medina betw. Aws and Khazraj leaves both exhausted.
- 619 Death of Khadīja.
 - Death of Abū Ṭālib.
- 620 First visit of Medinan representatives of Khazraj.
- 621 First `Aqaba at pilgrimage of 621 (12 men, bay`at al-nisā').
- 622 Second `Aqaba at pilgrimage of 622 (75, *bay'at al-ḥarb*). July 16. 1st Day of Hijra.
- 624 Nakhla expedition (`Abdallah b. Jaḥsh).

Badr.

After Badr, return to *qibla* of Mecca and establishment of fast of Ramaḍān. Banishment of the Banū Qaynuqā` (Muslim woman's skirt in market).

625 Uhud.

Banishment of the Banū al-Naḍīr to Khaybar. (failure to pay blood wit and attempt on Muḥammad's life).

627 Khandaq.

Surrender of Banū Qurayṇa after accusation of helping enemy at Khandaq. "Arbitration" of Sa`d b. Mu`ādh.

628 Fall of Khaybar.

Story of Zaynab bt. al-Hārith at Khaybar.

- 629 Al-Ḥudaybiyya.
- 630 Capture of Mecca.
- 632 Farewell Pilgrimage

Death of Muḥammad.
